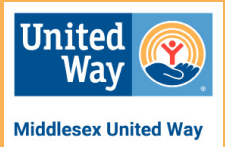


# LIFTING OUR COMMUNITY UP

Through the CT United Ways COVID-19 Fund, we disbursed over **\$800,000** directly to over **3,000** households throughout the state.

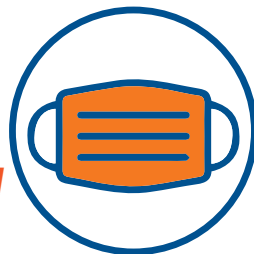


## MIDDLESEX UNITED WAY COVID-19 FUND

## MASKS TO THE COMMUNITY

We rallied volunteers throughout Middlesex County to provide over **50,000** masks to individuals and families, first responders, and essential workers.



## VIRTUAL VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

We created opportunities for volunteers to support our community partners. Over **100** cards were written to nursing home staff and residents and over **two hours** of children's books were read by volunteers.



## FEED THE HUNGRY

Distributed **6,000** boxes of food, totaling over **70,000** pounds of fresh produce, to families in need in Middlesex County.
