A GIFT OF \$1,000:



- Provides 3,226 meals for families in need.
- Provides "Welcome Home" kits for four families transitioning into their own homes with essential items like cleaning supplies, dishes and utensils, bed linens, and towels.
- Helps an ALICE family pay for a deposit to secure long-term housing and avoid homelessness.
- Helps 10 ALICE families afford two weeks of summer camp.
- Allows a child to attend three months of before- and after-school care
- Provides a series of lifesaving, one-on-one counseling sessions for those struggling with mental health issues.

A GIFT OF \$2,500:



- Enables a child to attend a quality pre-school program for the academic year, fostering critical social and emotional development so they are school ready.
- Allows four youth to participate in group therapy sessions for an entire year.
- Provides tutoring services and materials for 10 English as a Second Language students for an entire year.

A GIFT OF \$5,000:



- Provides a month's worth of mental health consultation to Middletown preschool programs and the families enrolled, providing early identification and intervention services to best prepare children for future success in school.
- Purchases gross motor equipment needed to assist five children with developmental delays.
- Funds a half year of individualized employment services for three adults with developmental and intellectual disabilities to receive help building a resume, developing interview skills, and applying for jobs.
