



East Haddam

For almost 90 years, Middlesex United Way has been working with our community to make East Haddam a great place to live and work. In the 2023-2024 Grant Cycle, we've awarded over \$260,000 to local agencies that focus on housing, education, wellness, financial stability, youth, and racial equity & inclusion.



In the past year, 228 residents of East Haddam called United Way's 2-1-1, a toll-free statewide helpline that operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. More than 41% of those calls were related to mental health and addiction.

## **MAKING AN IMPACT**

ALICE, an acronym for <u>Asset Limited</u>, <u>Income</u> Constrained, Employed, represents the men and women in CT's households of all ages and races who get up each day to go to work but aren't sure if they will be able to make ends meet.

The most recent data shows that 26% of East Haddam residents are considered below the ALICE threshold.
