MAKING AN IMPACT

ALICE, an acronym for Asset Limited, Income Constrained, Employed, represents the men and women in CT's households of all ages and races who get up each day to go to work but aren't sure if they'll be able to make ends meet.

The most recent data shows that 18% of Haddam residents are considered below the ALICE threshold.

A CALL FOR HELP

In the past year, 159 residents of Haddam called United Way's 2-1-1, a toll-free statewide helpline that operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Close to 37% of those calls were related to mental health and addiction.
